

Religious Ed. PLAN During COVID-19

Arrival and dismissal of students. All Students are to be dropped off at the Main Entrance of the Church at St. Mary's, at St. Rita's they are to be dropped of at Main Entrance to the Hall. Parents are to meet their child or children at the Main Entrance.

Cleaning and disinfecting of the building, common spaces and classrooms, both before and after the program. All Classrooms will be cleaned after students are dismissed. Bathrooms will be cleaned too. Bathroom use will be granted by the Religious Ed. teacher for one child at a time for grades 1-8. Teacher will take kindergarten class as a group.

Details regarding use of cohorts, social distancing and wearing of masks. Teachers and students will wear masks in hallways, while taking students to the classroom, when taking kindergarten students to bathroom as a group, individual students when they go to bathroom. While in class the teacher may lower mask to teach lesson, and students lower theirs while being social distanced.

Family's responsibilities for masks, hand sanitizer. Families are to provide masks for their children. They may provide them small bottles of hand sanitizer, but there will be hand sanitizer throughout the building. They will disinfect their hands before class, after the use of bathroom, and after class.

Limiting number of persons who may be in the building. Due to the virus we are being asked for parents to drop children off at Main Entrance, and not walk throughout the building. When picking your child up to wait at the Main Entrance. Parents are not to go to classrooms.

Keeping a child home. You are to keep your child home if the child or children have one or more of these symptoms

- a fever Of 100. 4, or higher
 - a cough,
 - shortness of breath or difficulty of breathing
- Two or more of the following symptoms

- Sore throat
- Runny nose
- Congestion
- Chills
- New lack of smell or taste
- Muscle pain
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Headache
- Diarrhea
